## Guide To The Exhibition

Significant artist 'pairs' are arranged chronologically by their dominant period, style or relevant subject matter. Where their work has appeared in a significant Gallery exhibition details follow. Non-Gallery initiated and non-curated recurrent exhibitions are unrepresented. This is not an exhaustive listing and the Gallery's exhibition index is available for lengthier consultation.

There are three 'ensemble' displays: S.H. Ervin and Captain Coghill represent 'the collectors'. International commodity trading gave both men the means to pursue the challenges of collecting and both collections are now cared for by the National Trust. A small display shows collection conservation in progress.

There are two 'irregularities': Nan Hortin and Carla Cescon's work has not previously appeared in the Gallery. Lack of available work meant that Hortin, a leading light in the Studio of Realist Artists, was not represented in Aspects of Australian Figurative Painting 1942–1962 (1984). Artist and curator, Mikala Dwyer, has curated 'fresh' work by Carla Cescon. Since Dwyer's memorable installation (an archway made of bread loaves) in Fresh Art (1989), her work is now internationally acclaimed. She introduces Cescon in this mutuality of spirit.

Curators are indicated by their initials. In the exhibition, each 'art pair' is introduced by an essay by a significant curator, writer or art historian, created either singly or in collaboration.
