

PRIZED POSSESSIONS

Works from the National Trust Collection 12-27 November 2022



Prized Possessions brings together some of the finest pieces from the National Trust collections - showcasing a number of recently works restored as part of a conservation appeal - as well as other important works from the collection.

The National Trust collection includes 60,000 objects of remarkable diversity of style, period and country of origin. The National Trust's 20 house museums across NSW include many intact collections with direct provenance to a particular place. These collections are important as they provide visitors with the chance to glimpse back, and reflect the interests of the original inhabitants of the houses whether they were innkeepers, explorers or a governor.

The significance of the Trust's collection also reflects the manner in which the work of art was acquired, with many items being gifts or bequests which tell us much about the tastes and personal stories of the donor – and what they considered their 'prized possessions'.

Properties featured in the exhibition include objects from Saumarez, Armidale; Miss Traill's House & Garden, Bathurst; Retford Park, Bowral; Bedervale, Braidwood; Lindesay, Darling Point; Norman Lindsay Gallery, Springwood; Riversdale, Goulburn; Old Government House, Parramatta; Golden Vale, Sutton Forrest; S.H. Ervin Gallery, Sydney and Woodford Academy, Woodford.
